I understand that parking on the Bishop Grimes Jr. / Sr. High School campus is a privilege and not a right. I also understand that violating school rules, including being habitually tardy to school, may result in this privilege being suspended or even being permanently revoked.

Students are not to arrive on or ride motorcycles or similar-type vehicles. Parking on school property is at your own risk and the speed limit on school property is always *less than 10mph*, including the circular driveway in front of the school. **Students are to park in the last three rows of the parking lot behind the school in a single designated parking space.** Students are not to park in fire lanes, handicapped parking, reserved spaces, on the grass, or block lanes of traffic or the school garages. Student parking stickers are not transferable. Students need to drive in a safe and responsible manner at all times on school property, and students must arrive to school on time.

Students must be aware of the hazards and implications of transporting other students to or from school. It is the policy of Bishop Grimes Jr. / Sr. High School to discourage students from transporting other students. The school does not take responsibility for students who violate this policy.

The student's current parking sticker must be affixed to the window on the passenger's side rear window. Vehicles that are parked in the parking lot without a sticker risk being towed at the owner's expense.

In order to be issued a parking sticker, this completed and signed form must be returned as well as a copy of a valid driver's license and a \$10 registration fee. Once these three things have been turned in to Mr. Kinne a parking sticker will be issued and the student may begin parking on campus. A two week grace period is granted at the start of the school year. Failure to display a parking sticker will result in a student's car being towed at the student's expense.
