

Bishop Grimes High School Summer Driver Education

The Summer Driver Education course being offered at Bishop Grimes consists of classroom instruction and in-car instruction. Students have three sessions of in-car instruction **AND** three sessions of classroom instruction per week. The course is approved by the New York State Education Department. Successful completion will entitle the student to receive a MV 285 (formerly know as a “blue card”) and an insurance reduction certificate.
